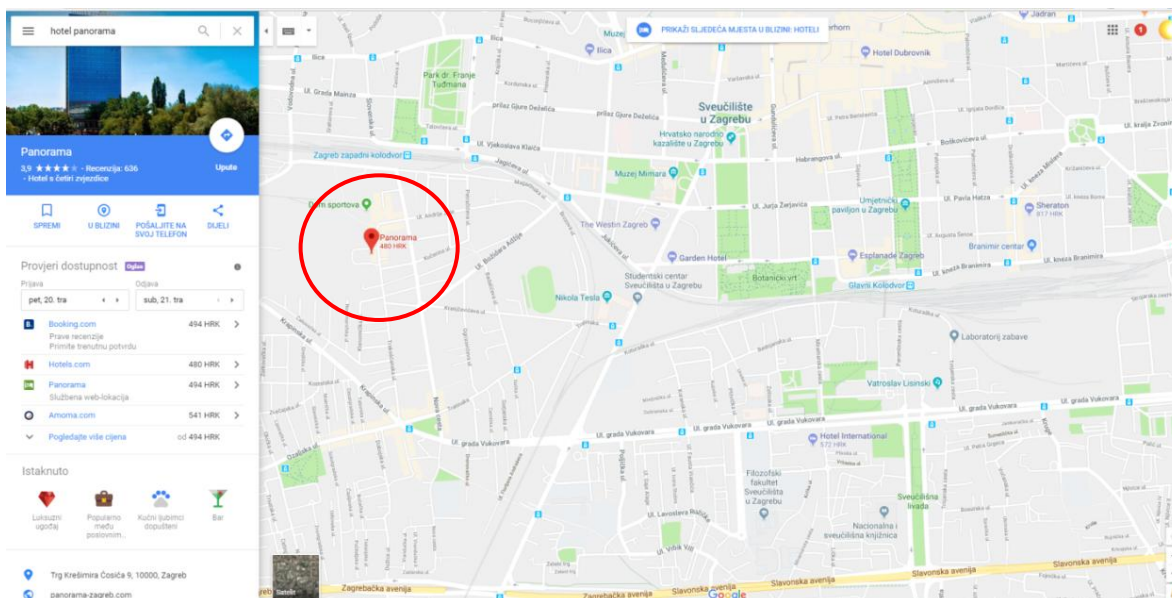

Panorama Zagreb is located in the Trešnjevka neighborhood, close to the sports hall Dom Sportova, a central place for numerous sports and cultural events.

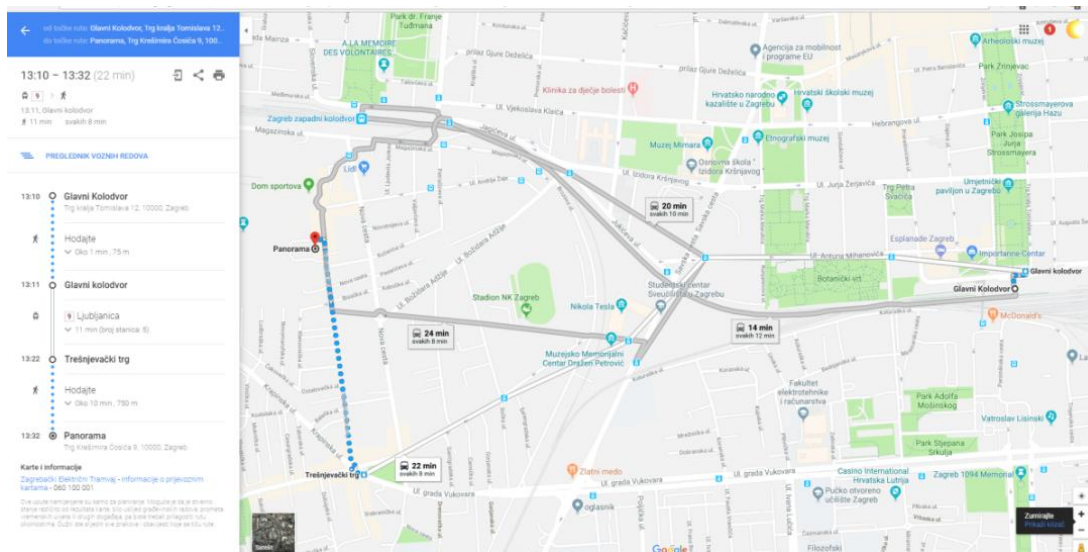


Public transportation in the city of Zagreb

The hotel is situated across from the sports hall Dom Sportova. **Tram lines 3, 9 and 12** bring you to the hotel. Get off at the Trešnjevački Square tram stop. More information on public transportation in the city of Zagreb is available [here](#).

Railway

If you are travelling by train, take the tram line 9 (direction west, towards Ljubljana) from the Central Railway Station. Get off at the 4th stop (Trešnjevački Square). Then walk for 5-10 minutes north.



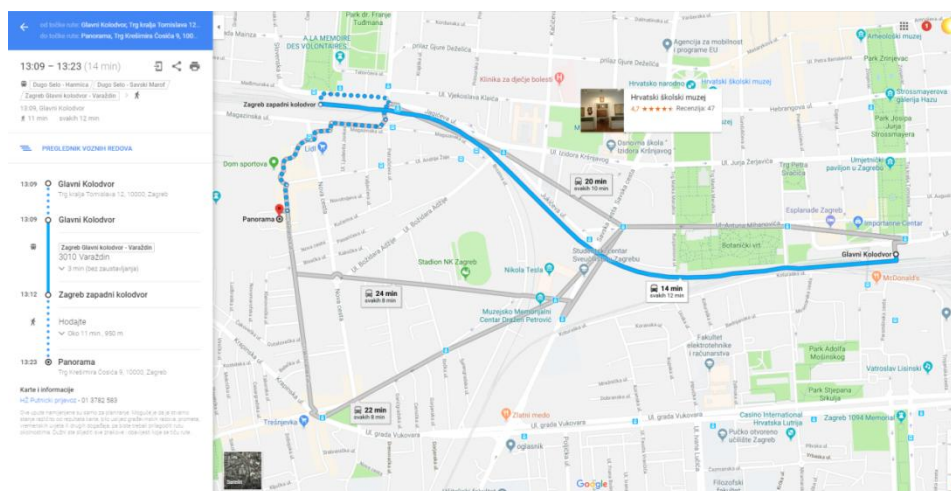
Taxi options

Uber – 20-30 HRK from Central Railway/Bus Station to the hotel

Taxi Zagreb – tel. +385 1 1717, 10 HRK start and 6 HRK/km

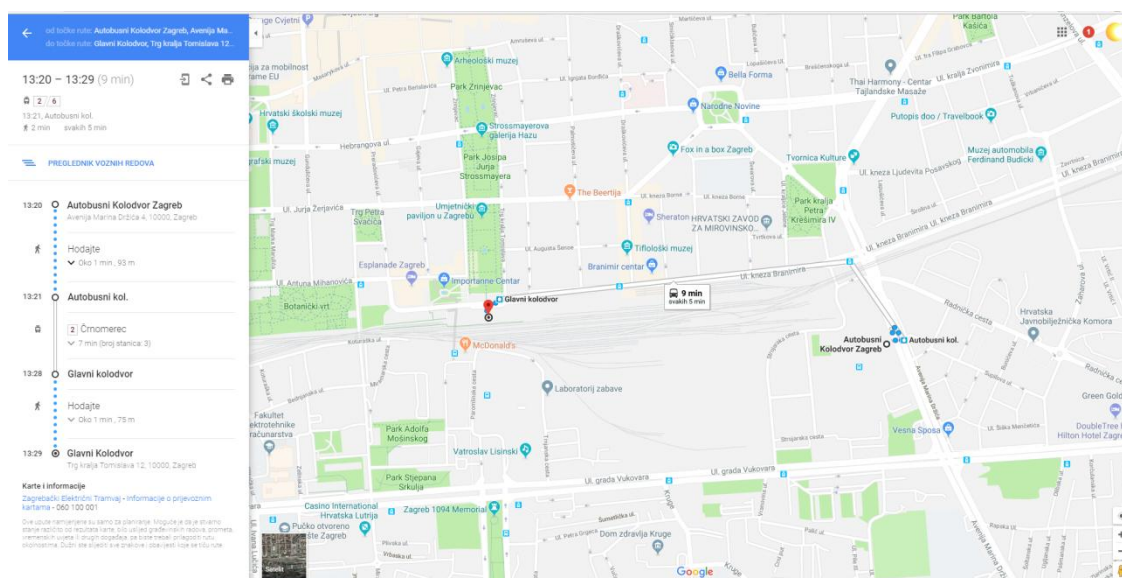
Cammeo – tel. +385 1 1212, 6 HRK start and 6 HRK/km

Other option from the Central Railway Station is by train. You can choose trains toward Zaprešić, Harmica and Zabok/Varaždin (direction west). Get off at the 1st stop (Zapadni kolodvor). The hotel is situated to the south of the train station, walking distance around up to 10 minutes.



Central Bus Station

From the Central Bus Station take the tram to the Central Railway Station (direction Črnomerec, tram lines 2 or 6). Get off at the 3rd stop. Then take the tram line 9 (direction Ljubljana). Get off at the 4th stop (Trešnjevski Square). The hotel is situated to the north of the square, walking distance 5-10 minutes. For more information look at the **Railway**.



By car

From the West

If you are coming from the West (highway A2, Bregana border crossing, Slovenia) take the Zagreb West exit. Continue driving along on Zagrebačka Avenue (9 km), then turn left on Savska Street and follow the signs for Panorama Zagreb.

From the South

If you are on highway A1 towards Zagreb, after the toll station continue on Jadranska Avenue until you get to the roundabout. Take the 3rd exit on the roundabout and continue driving on Jadranski Bridge. At the first traffic lights, turn right on Savska Street and continue driving towards the city centre following the signs for Panorama Zagreb.

The hotel has an open parking lot for the hotel guests.

From the East

If you are coming from the East (highway A5 - Slavonia), after the toll station, drive straight down on Slavonska Avenue until you get to the centre, then turn right on Savska Street and follow the signs for Panorama Zagreb.
